Sorority Aims to Impact Girls and Women in Hattiesburg, Mississippi

Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® to donate personal products for girls and young women.

(September 13, 2023) – More than 275 members of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® (AKA) will convene this Saturday at Lake Terrace Convention Center for the South Eastern Region Cluster meeting. They will arrive with feminine hygiene products for girls and women in Hattiesburg, Mississippi. The items will be collected at the meeting and donated to the local non-profit organization, The Loftin Place for Women and Children, for distribution to deserving individuals.

According to South Eastern Regional Director Tracey Morant Adams, Ph.D., more than 1000 items will be collected. “While we are here to conduct the business of AKA, we also care to show up as compassionate citizens who serve others. This is in keeping with our mission of service to all mankind,” Adams said.

Hattiesburg is the location of the first of eight meetings that AKA will host across the region this year. At each meeting, the organization will collect personal care items for women and girls.

“We chose Hattiesburg because of its location, facilities, and great Southern hospitality. It is our desire to give back to the host community. We are thrilled to be here,” said Adams.

The day-long meeting begins at 8:30 am.
