Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® will donate personal care products to benefit local students.

(October 20, 2023) – The South Eastern Region of Alpha Kappa Alpha (AKA) Sorority, Incorporated® returns to Tupelo, Mississippi, Saturday, October 21, 2023, for its Cluster 1 meeting. The members are expected to bring hundreds of feminine hygiene products for donation to the Lee County School District.

South Eastern Regional Director Tracey Morant Adams, Ph.D., said the gathering in Tupelo is an opportunity to contribute to the host community. “While we are here to conduct the business of AKA, we care to show up as compassionate citizens who serve others. This effort aligns with our mission of service to all mankind,” Adams said.

Tupelo is the location for one of eight South Eastern Region Cluster meetings this year. At each meeting, the organization will donate personal care items to local organizations that serve women and girls.

In 2022, the South Eastern Region hosted its Statewide Cluster in Tupelo, attracting hundreds of AKA members from throughout Mississippi and beyond. “We chose this community because of its ability to host a membership organization of our size and for the great Southern hospitality we’ve experienced here,” said Adams.

The day-long meeting begins at 8:30 am on October 21, 2023, at Cadence Bank Arena.
